## PRESBYTERY SEMINAR by Lynda Smith

Pat Williams, Marg. McGillivray, Jennifer Davis and Lynda Smith attended the Steve Taylor seminar at Hoppers Crossing UC in May. Steve is the Principal of the Uniting Theological College Adelaide.

The seminar looked at discernment, imagination and change. Steve was an enthusiastic and vibrant presenter. We were asked to view and analyse a contemporary painting by Kees de Kort of Phillip and the Ethiopian from the Book of Acts. Steve read a children's story to us and then asked groups to see how we are inspired in our Christian journey and how we cultivate Christianity in our lives. For the change and mission component Steve referred us to a part of the National Church Life Survey, <http://www.ncls.org.au/default.aspx?sitemapid=6163> which reminds us that in order to initiate change, 3-4 people are required as you always need a diverse range of talents to create new mission directions. The 12 leadership strength areas are to: listen, connect, envision, explore, inspire, empower, structure, communicate, optimism, act, resolve and to learn. Steve reminded us also that sometimes our personal plan of action can be changed by the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. He was quite determined to set up a coffee shop at a church he was involved in but by simply meeting the need of one person who had lots of questions they set up a discussion group at a local coffee shop and called it Espresso and it was successful.
