### Messy Church @ Home—July Puppet ideas

Puppets can be sock puppets, hand puppets, finger puppets, paper bag puppets, marionettes, right up to ventriloquist dolls.

The idea with a puppet is you are creating a character to fill in a role in a story. You speak the part but have the puppet act out their part.

Some possible stories, but you can use any that you want (this is the same list that I gave you last month for the Lego models):

The garden of Eden—Genesis 2: 4 – 3: 13

Moses and the Ten Commandments—Exodus 34: 29-33

Daniel in the lion's den—Daniel 6: 11-22

Joshua and the battle of Jericho—Joshua 6: 1-20

Jonah and the whale—Jonah 1: 11-17

Noah and the Ark—Genesis 6: 9 - 8: 11

The birth of Jesus—Luke 2: 1-20

Jesus entering Jerusalem on a donkey—Luke 19: 28-40

Jesus calms the sea-Mark 4: 35-41

Jesus' crucifixion—Mark 15: 21-32
