



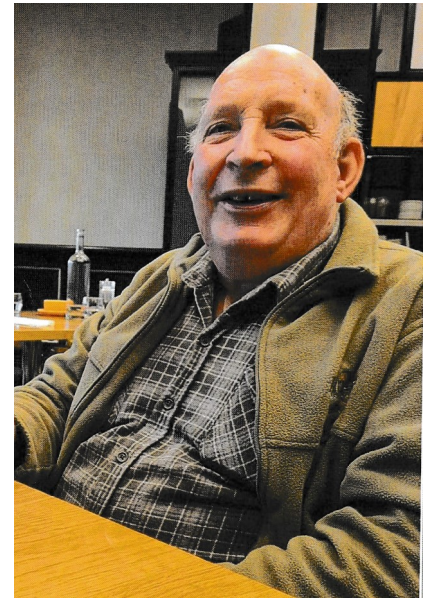

Graham had a strong faith in God and ideas of service. Before taking over the family farm he had worked as an educator with National Parks and with his own wildlife experience business. Graham recommended the Women for Women stoves project which became our loose change project in 2020. He also suggested projecting the church sound out the front door and with the help of a Presbytery grant this was finally turned on just before his death. Graham's service to the church goes back before Drysdale to being a regular service leader at Mt Beauty and a youth group leader in many places. He most certainly faithfully served his Lord.
