PROFILE—PETER SIERAKOWSKI

Peter was born in Melbourne and lived with his family in Prahran. His father was a baker and mother a secretary. He has one sister. He was raised by his mother when the parents divorced but his father remained an active part of his life. He attended Hawksburn State School and then Prahran Technical School. Peter learnt early about money through a paper round. He was a member of the Prahran Try Boys Club and became a very good swimmer through this club. He joined the Malvern Baths club and went on to be a School Boys Champion and represented Victoria in swimming. The family later moved to Burwood and Peter changed to Burwood Tech. Not content with



just one sport he turned his interest in horses into show jumping and eventually got his own horse and won many events.

Leaving school Peter got an apprenticeship as a butcher working in Richmond for seven years before going to New Zealand and butchering for another two years. Butchering was difficult because Peter was left handed. On returning to Australia Peter was offered a truck driving position by Lindsay Fox and stayed there for fifteen years.

Peter met Claire on a blind date and they married in 1975. Shortly after Peter's mum bought a hotel in Toolleen (near Bendigo) and asked Peter and Claire to run it for her. Next they bought a farm of 71 acres near Kyabram and later moved into Kyabram and returned to carting grain before retiring.

Peter and Claire adopted two boys and then became involved in Kyabram Football Club. They now have six grandchildren. They moved to Clifton Springs in 2015, chosen because it was near the beach and good public transport. Peter bought himself a small boat and spends lots of time fishing, working at the Men's Shed and helping others; he knew when he retired that he needed things to do. He helps with the church mowing and working bees.

Peter has not been much of a church attender but calls himself a supportive believer. He was a member of the Prahran Church of England Boys Choir; as a teenager was a member of the Armidale Presbyterian Boys Brigade; and then with Claire at the Uniting Church.

The special birthday lunches are returning this year commencing on Sunday 5 March to celebrate those who missed out being celebrated during 2020, 2021 and 2022—there are 22




