# PROFILE—RHONDA LYONS

Rhonda joined Drysdale UC last year coming from Brown Hill UC in Ballarat. Since then she has become immersed in the church, becoming an elder and member of Church Council in February.

Rhonda was born in Ballarat North and attended the Knox Presbyterian Sunday School. She has a sister and brother. Her mum died when she was ten. She attended Ballarat Grammar School because her mum wanted the children to have a church school education. Rhonda said she enjoyed this with its twice weekly chapel services. She went on to Teachers College at Ballarat and became a primary school teacher, who mostly taught in Catholic primary schools.




While teaching in Warrnambool she married Tony and birthed two children—a boy and girl. Later there was a marriage breakdown. At Warrnambool she was involved as the school representative with the chaplaincy program that was run by the Uniting Church through Access Ministries, with their school having a chaplain and a social worker for a very successful program.

With her children at university, Rhonda moved to the Gold Coast to help her brother and attended a Pentecostal church with him. They suggested that she attend a Walk to Emmaus program—a spiritual retreat that really refreshed her and gave her a special feeling of God; she went back 3 or 4 times as a course helper. After about three years she moved back to Ballarat to be closer to her sister and started attending Brown Hill UC. Here at a mid week service she started to learn to arrange the service or to provide the sermon.

Rhonda's daughter is now a veterinary nurse and her son is an IT specialist. She has one granddaughter and another grandchild on the way. She moved to Clifton Springs to be close to her sister who now has MND. She enjoys swimming with her sister, and walking.

Rhonda attends church because it is her faith; it re-energises her for the week and helps her to be a disciple of Christ.
