SYNOD 2023

Rev Karen and Wayne will be attending Synod from 18-21 November at Box Hill. The theme this year is "We belong to the day" based on 1 Thessalonians 5: 8.



The Moderator, Rev David Fotheringham, says that Synod is about taking action for faith and hope in the light of God's calling.

The opening worship will include guest speaker, Brooke Prentis, an aboriginal international Christian leader. Daily bible studies will be led by Rev Assoc Prof Robyn Witaker, from Pilgrim College.

During the meeting, which is also the annual general meeting of the VicTas Synod, reports from the various committees and bodies of the church will be received, election of the next Moderator will take place and there will be discussions about important aspects for the church including Act2—the national Assembly future of the church project, and the Faithful Futures Project (FFP)—the Synod project about the future. Resolutions about social justice

issues will also be raised and considered.

As the FFP says it is important to bear witness to the renewing faithful love of God.


VALÉ AUDREY SHEPHERD

We sadly note the passing of Audrey Shepherd. Audrey was born in Melbourne and attended Princes Hill State School and then the Convent of Mercy in Fitzroy. After finishing school she went into men's tailoring with Buckley & Nunn. Audrey's family were not really interested in the church but a neighbour took her to Sunday School at the East Brunswick Methodist church when she was 3 years old—and she has not left the church since. She met Bill at church, where his father was the minister, and they married in 1950. Audrey also served as a Sunday School teacher.

Bill and Audrey purchased a 5 acre property in Murradoc Road in 1953 where they established a poultry farm and hatchery. They had two daughters and a son and there are now two grandchildren. Audrey and Bill joined Drysdale Methodist church in 1953 with Bill in the choir and the Property committee and Audrey in the UCAF. Bill took the lead in the building of the new church hall, which is named Shepherd Hall. Audrey was heavily involved in the fundraising activities of that

time. Audrey continued as a member of the UCAF and was a volunteer at the Op Shop for some time.

We praise God for Audrey's commitment to the church.

A flood struck a town, and one man was stuck on his roof. He prayed, asking God to save him. Soon, a rowboat came by. The rower yelled,


